- Make a compelling case on behalf of the nominee(s) for why the individual or organization deserves to receive the Jeanne Clarke Award

- Your name and contact information
- Name and contact information of the nominee (if you know it)

The Jeanne Clarke Local History Award celebrates local history, highlights the library's role in preserving and promoting local history, and recognizes individuals and groups for their efforts in local history.

Although the primary goal is to recognize the history of Prince George and the surrounding area, local history is broadly defined to include all of Northern BC from north of Williams Lake and stretching from the Pacific Coast to the Alberta border, so that historical work with a regional focus is eligible for recognition.
