The Nechako Branch of the library is located in the Hart Shopping Centre.

There is free parking in front of the building.



There is a materials drop beside the door. You can return books and other materials here if the library is closed.

The Nechako Branch is all on one level.
There are no stairs or elevator.



We have a walker with a basket for public use beside the front door.



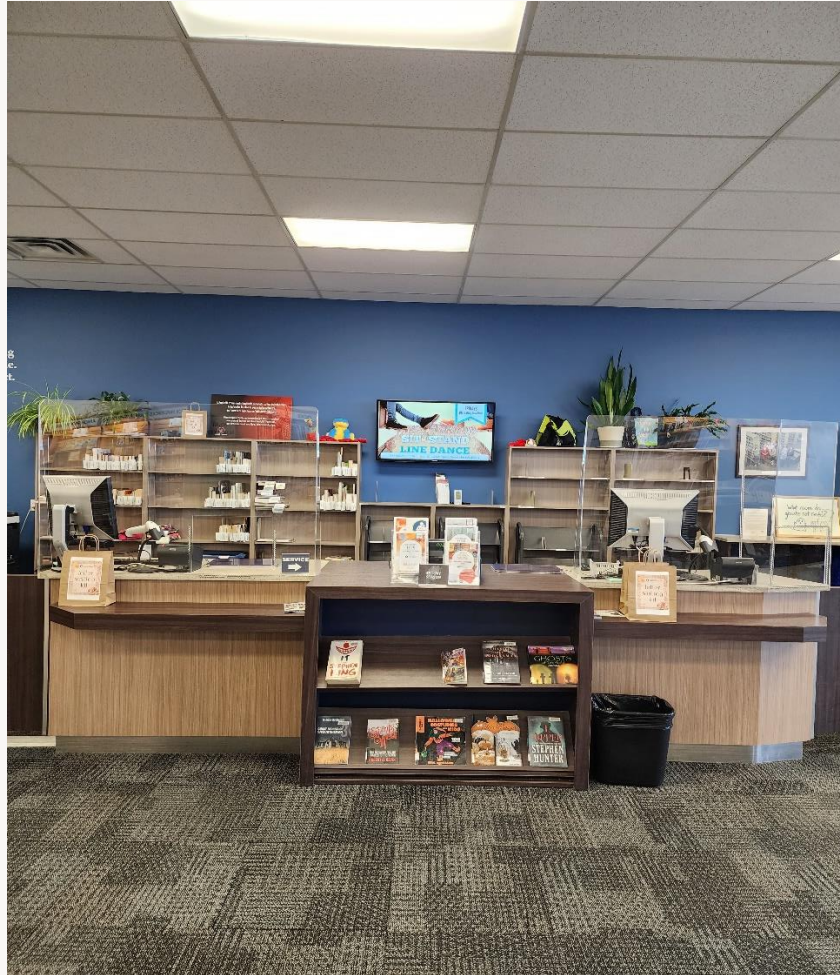
We have shopping baskets with wheels and handles near the front entrance.

card.

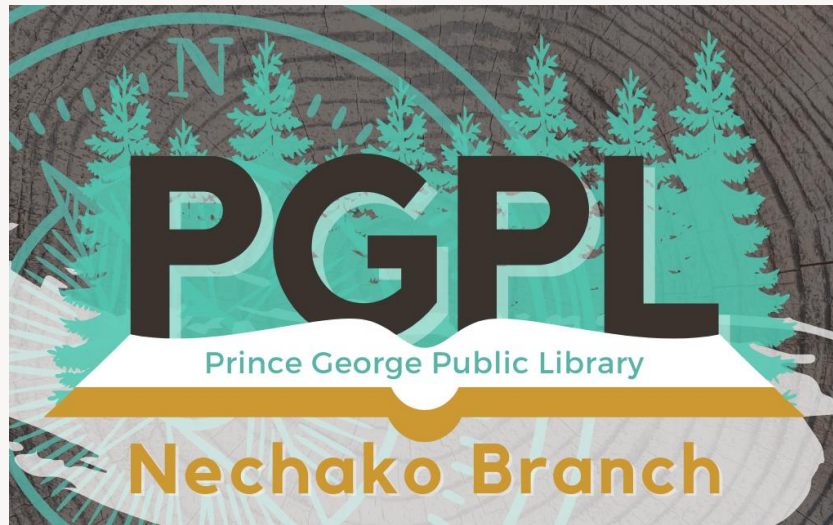
They can also help you find books, DVDs,

This is what a library card looks like:



You must have a piece of ID to get a library card.

Your ID must have your legal name on it.

Children under 12 years old need a parent or guardian with them to get a library card.

Staff members wear silver badges with
"Staff" written on them.



Staff like to answer your questions and can
help you find things in the library.

Anyone can use a library computer for 30 minutes every day.



You can print, fax, scan, and photocopy in the computer lab.

You can ask about how to use a computer at any service desk.

There are two washrooms at the back of the library.

One washroom only allows one user at time and the other has two stalls.

Both are wheelchair accessible although the washroom at the end of the hall may not allow for wide turns.





The soap in the washrooms has no smell.
The hand sanitizer has a strong smell.

The Nechako Branch library is often quiet and not as busy as the Bob Harkins Branch.



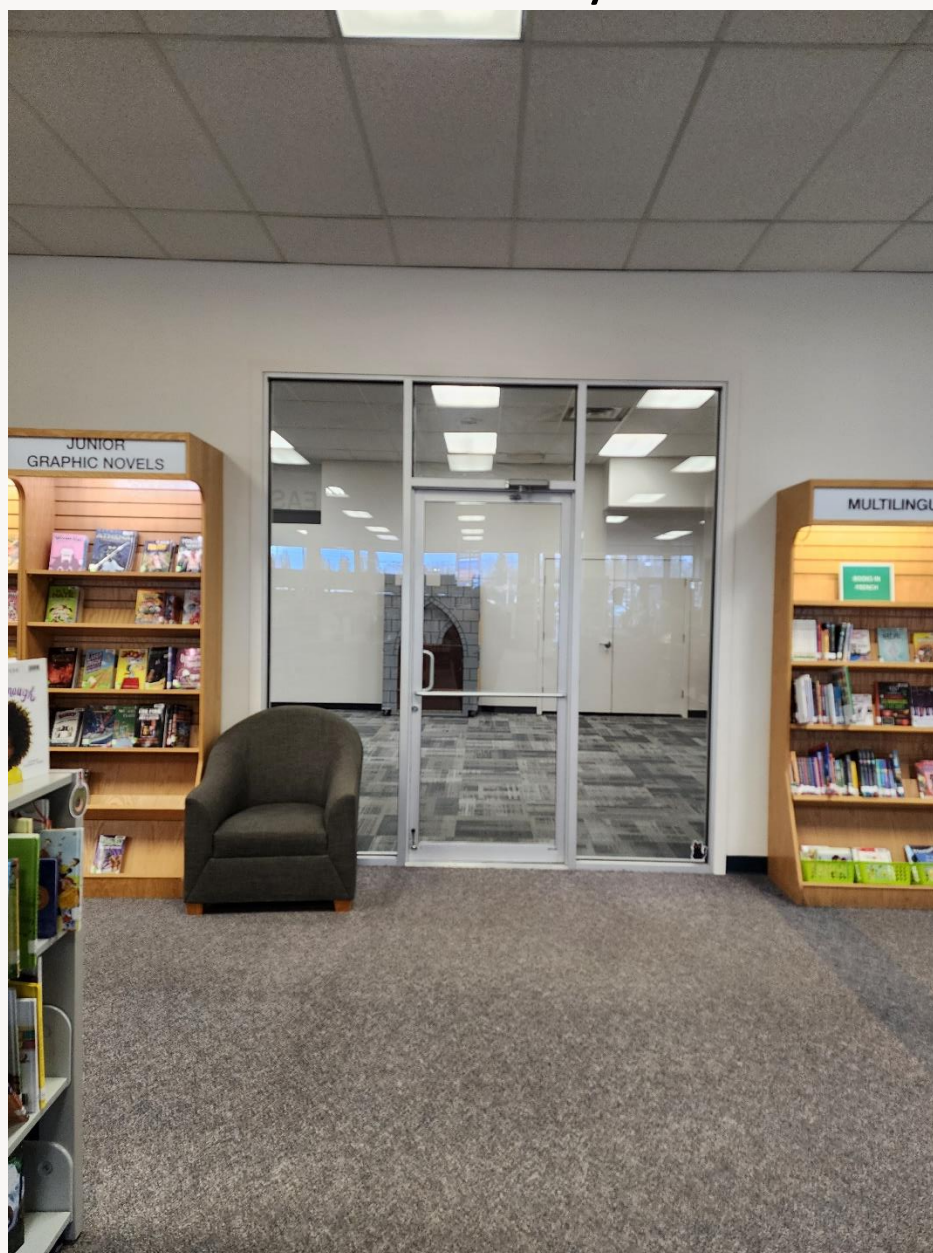
