



HOW IT WORKS

When you email us about a completed task, an entry form will be completed on your behalf.

THE RULES

You must be between the ages of 10-18 or entering into Grade 5 this September. Each challenge can be completed only once and draw winners must be able to come to a Prince George Public Library branch to pick up their prizes.

THE CHALLENGE

1. Attend a summer program at BHBR and tell us about it.
2. Create a comic based on a scene from your favourite book or a book you've read this summer. (Min. 5 panels or one 8" by 11" paper). (bonus entry if it's in color)
3. Read a graphic novel (and tell us which one).
4. Create a body biography for your favourite book character. (Draw & colour a full body portrait of the character and write a description of them)
5. Write a haiku poem.
6. Play a board game (and tell us which one).
7. Read a fantasy book and write Fanfiction (min. 300 words). Please include a title and tell us which book it's based on.

THE CHALLENGE

8. Read a novel by an author you have never read before and write a review about it (Min. 100 words).

9. Read a non-fiction book and tell us what it was about and one interesting fact that you learnt.

10. Perform a random act of kindness! Tell us about one nice thing that you did for a friend, family member or stranger this summer.

11. Go outside and play! Take a photo and do a quick write up of about a cool outdoor experience that you had!

12. Going on summer vacation? Send us a postcard or drop one off at the library. Make sure it has your full name, your phone # or email, and “Ten to Teens Summer Challenge” marked on it.
