You can also email the library at ask@pgpl.ca.


The library is located in downtown Prince George, in Canada Games Plaza.



You can enter the library from the plaza.

The parking lot is located under the library.

If you are driving, you can park in the parking lot.



You can enter the library from the parking lot.


You can choose to take the elevator or the stairs to the main floor.



The elevator has glass doors.

It has a speaker that tells you what floor you are on.

The staircase has many windows. It can be loud when it is busy.



There is a sign outside the elevator. It tells you what is on each floor of the library.



When you enter, you will see signs with rules to keep everyone safe during the COVID-19 pandemic.



One of the rules is to wear a mask.

Staff can give you a mask if you do not have one.

If you are unable to wear a mask, you do not have to.

There can only be 20 visitors in the library at one time.

If the library is full when you arrive, you will have to wait.



When someone else leaves, you can enter.

The Service Desk is on the main floor.

Staff at this desk can help you get a library card.

They can also help you find books, DVDs, and other library materials.



Sometimes there is a lineup at this desk. The stickers on the floor show you where to stand when you are in the lineup.

To get a library card, you will need to show staff a piece of identification.

It must have your legal name on it.

This is what a library card looks like:



Children under 12 years old need a parent or guardian with them to get a library card.

Staff members wear silver badges with "Staff" written on them.



Staff like to answer your questions and can give you a tour of the library.

You can use an internet computer for 45 minutes.



Ask at the Service Desk if you would like to use a computer.

There are washrooms on the main floor.

One is for men and one is for women.



There is a private washroom with 1 toilet. Anybody can use this washroom.

The soap in the bathrooms has no smell. The hand sanitizer has a strong smell.

Sometimes there are few people in the library and it is quiet.



When there are lots of people in the library, it can be loud.

The lights are very bright and make a humming noise.


The library offers many virtual programs.

All programs are free.

You can attend programs from home.
You will need a computer, tablet, or phone connected to the internet.

You will have to register for some programs.

You can register for programs at pgpl.ca/events.



Ask a staff member if you need help registering for a program.

Parts of the library are closed during the COVID-19 pandemic.



Ask a staff member if you need something from a closed area of the library.

The library may change often during the pandemic.

You can phone the library before you visit to ask about any recent changes.
