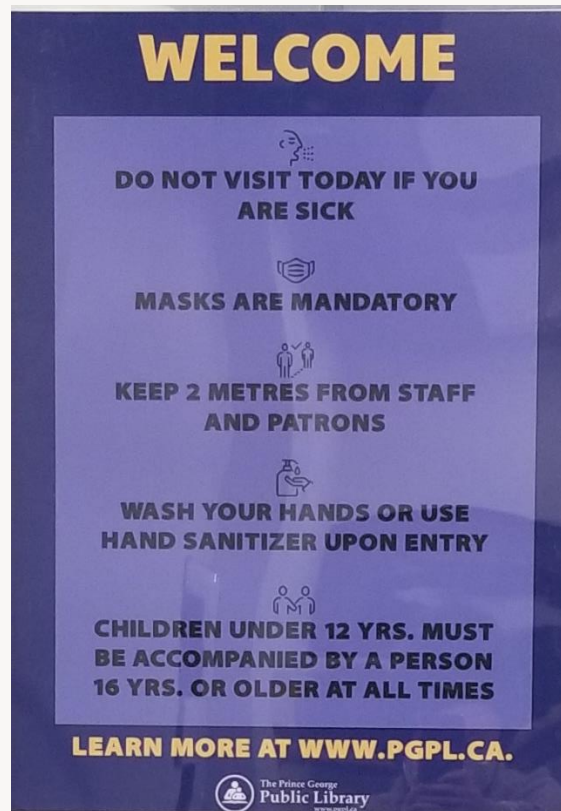
The Nechako Branch of the library is located in the Hart Shopping Centre.

There is free parking in front of the building.



There is a return slot beside the door.
You can return books and other materials
at the return slot.

When you enter, you will see signs with rules to keep everyone safe during the COVID-19 pandemic.



One of the rules is to wear a mask.

Staff can give you a mask if you do not have one.

If you are unable to wear a mask, you do not have to.

There can only be 15 visitors in the library
at one time.

If the library is full when you arrive, you
will have to wait.



When someone else leaves, you can enter.

The Nechako Branch is all on one level.
There are no stairs or elevator.

When you enter, you will see the Service Desk.



Staff at this desk can help you get a library card.

They can also help you find books, DVDs, and other library materials.

To get a library card, you will need to show staff a piece of identification.
It must have your legal name on it.

This is what a library card looks like:



Children under 12 years old need a parent or guardian with them to get a library card.

Staff members wear silver badges with "Staff" written on them.



Staff like to answer your questions and can give you a tour of the library.

You can use an internet computer for 45 minutes.



Ask at the Service Desk if you would like to use a computer.

The washrooms are at the back of the library.

One is for men and one is for women.

There are accessible stalls in each washroom.



The soap in the bathrooms has no smell.
The hand sanitizer has a strong smell.

The Nechako Branch library is often very quiet.




The lights are very bright and make a humming noise.
