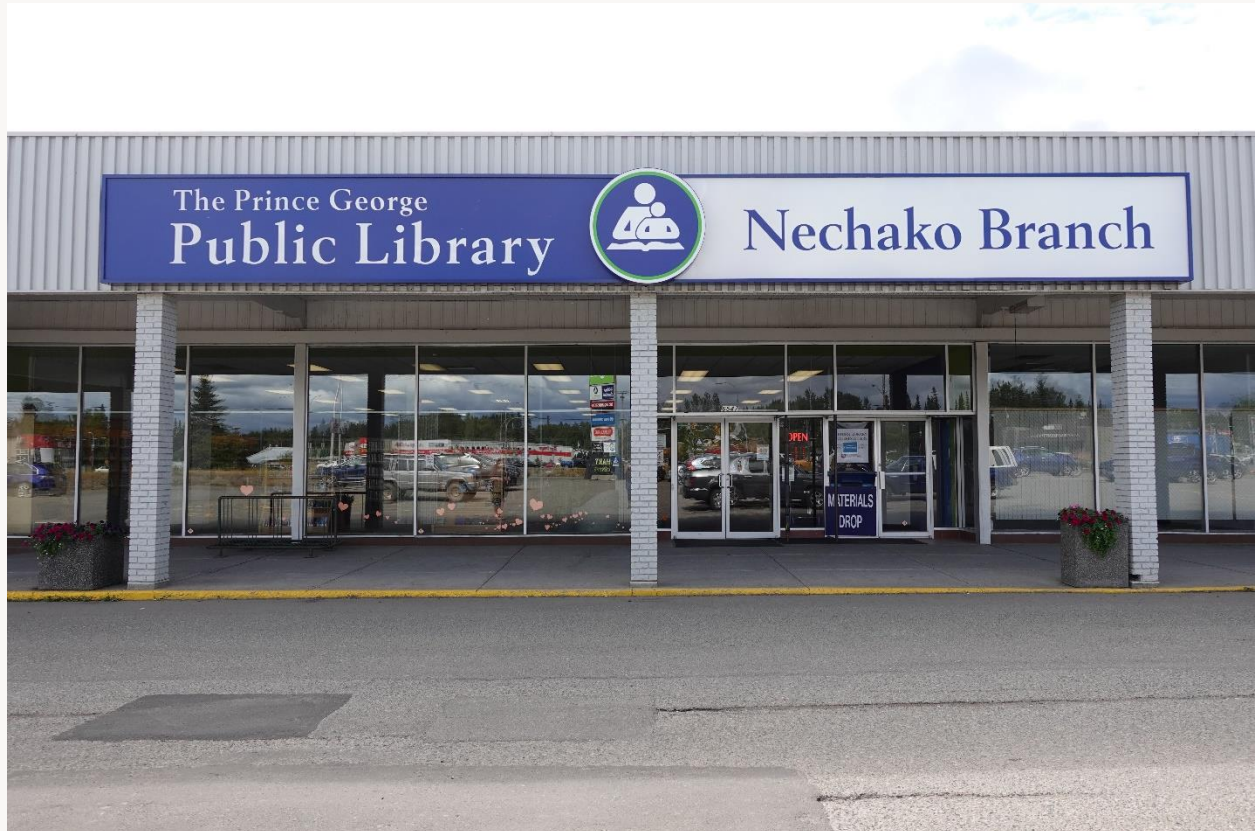

Saturday	10:00am to 2:30pm
Sunday	Closed

holidays.

Call **250-563-9251**, then press **300** if you have questions before you visit the library.



Press **100** to ask about library cards.

Press **108** to ask about child and teen books or programs.

Press **141** to ask about adult books or programs.

The Nechako Branch of the library is located in the Hart Shopping Centre.

There is free parking in front of the building.



There is a return slot beside the door.
You can return books and other materials
at the return slot.

When you enter, you will see the Service Desk.



Staff at this desk can help you get a library card.

They can also help you find books, DVDs, and other library materials.

To get a library card, you will need to show staff a piece of identification.
It must have your legal name on it.

This is what a library card looks like:



Children under 12 years old need a parent or guardian with them to get a library card.

Staff members wear silver badges with
"Staff" written on them.



Staff like to answer your questions and can
give you a tour of the library.

To log-in to the computers use your library card and PIN number or ask staff at the Service Desk for a 30-minute guest pass.



The washrooms are at the back of the library to the right.



The soap in the bathrooms has no smell.
The hand sanitizer has a strong smell.

This is the magazine display. Feel free to check out and borrow them.

This is the Nechako Multiple-Purpose Room.




It is often used for events and programming.
