### **POLICY 2.11: CHILDREN'S ACCESS**

- 2.11.1 A Child is defined as 0-11 years of age. A Teen is defined as 12-18 years of age. An adult is 19 years and above.
- 2.11.2 Children are issued Library cards identical in form to adult Library cards. A parent or guardian's signature is required on the child's application form, to ensure the parent or guardian understands his or her responsibility relating to the child's use of the Public Library. The parent or guardian accepts responsibility for the choice of books and materials, as well as for the loss of, or damage to, Library materials borrowed on the Library membership card.
- 2.11.3 The Prince George Public Library allows those children wishing to do so to use the adult departments. The Library is not responsible for the type of material selected or viewed by the child.
