POLICY 2.4: PROOF OF RESIDENCE

- 2.4.1 Persons applying for Library membership must supply satisfactory proof of residence. Persons not able to supply proof of their current residence at the time they are applying for membership will have 30 days in which to do so, after which time their membership will be expired until such proof is shown. Persons under the age of fourteen may become members on the Library's receipt of the signature of the parent or guardian along with proof of residence with proof of residence and with the signature of their parent or guardian on their library card application.
- 2.4.2. Non-resident and temporary residents or visitors may obtain Library memberships for a fee. See Section 2.3 for definitions of Residents.
